With your vision and ideas, this plan will identify what equitable neighborhood development looks like and map a concrete set of recommendations to move us towards this goal.

Our Baltimore Themes and Topics

The plan will build off of existing plans, such as the Sustainability Plan (2019) and cover topics including:

- Livable Places: Affordable Housing, Transit Oriented Development, Equitable Development, Historic Resources, and more
- Inclusive Economy: Workforce Development, Broadband and Digital Equity and more
- Harmony with Nature: Tree Canopy, Environmental Justice, and more
- Healthy Communities: Public Health Disparities, Food Access and Security, Green Spaces/Parks and more

Spring 2022 – Listening: Establishing Vision and Topics

Fall 2022 – Creating: Developing Recommendations

2023 – Drafting and Reviewing: Writing and Revising Plan
